

### **Project Timeline**




Anticipated 2021-2022 throughout the duration of the project.

- Concern about neighborhood streets being used as detour routes
- Ideas for traffic revisions on surrounding roads
- Concern over traffic queues during school pick-up and dropoff times
- Need for community notifications prior to and during construction









- The City of Sammamish gathered data in 2016 and 2017 during peak afternoon travel times
  - Peak morning travel times were also gathered and looked at in 2017
- Developed traffic model for current peak afternoon conditions
- Developed traffic model during peak afternoon construction conditions








### Traffic During Construction









# What to Expect During Construction


- One travel lane maintained in each direction
- Increased travel times
- Noise and vibrations
- Dust
- Bicycle and pedestrian access maintained
- Ongoing notification





### **Detour and Haul Routes**

- During intermittent, shortterm closures, traffic will be detoured
- Project haul routes will be in place to:
  - Keep construction traffic off of neighborhood streets
  - Maintain safety throughout the area during construction

- Determine permanent and temporary traffic management solutions based on community feedback
- Hold final design open house early 2018
- Future meetings and notifications prior to start of construction
