ABOUT PLAT & SHORT PLAT ALTERATION

Short plat alterations and plat alterations are required when an applicant requests a change to a recorded subdivision. These changes may include:

- Creation of additional lots
- Changes in open space requirements
- Recognition of an existing non-buildable lot
- Changes in the Hearing Examiner's conditions of approval

APPLICATION APPROVAL

A Short Plat Alteration is a Type 2 decision made by the Director.

A Plat Alteration is a Type 3 decision subject to a hearing and decision by the Hearing Examiner based on the recommendation of the Director.
